

# PADI Advanced Wreck Diver course

To enroll in the Advanced Wreck Diver course, you must be:

- A PADI **Enriched Air Diver**
- A PADI **Deep Diver**
- A PADI **Wreck Diver**
- At least 15 years old (based on maturity) and have a minimum of 30 logged dives
- A Medical Statement signed by a physician within the last 12 months

## What will you learn?

The Advanced Wreck Diver course consists of an extensive knowledge development seminar, a practical application workshop, a confined water training dive, and four open water training dives. You'll learn about:

- Wreck diving hazards, risks and responsibilities
- Team diving concept
- Wreck penetration equipment, limits, techniques, and emergencies

# Advanced Wreck Diver Course Fact Sheet

Make sure you meet the minimum pre-requisite requirements to enter the course of a PADI Advanced Open Water Diver, with Enriched Air Diver, Deep Diver, and Wreck Diver certifications with the logged dives appropriate.

## Course Costs

The cost for the academic presentation, practical application, confined water training, and the certification fee is \$350 per person.

The cost for the open water dives (which can be completed on one weekend) are in addition to the course cost and the diving/trip fees.

Also, recreational equipment may be used; however, technical equipment is ideal. The basic tec rig varies in price (\$1000 - \$1500) depending upon what you may already own.

Everyone will need their own set of recreation equipment (BCD, Regulator, Computer, and Wetsuit). Each student must have the specialized wreck diving equipment of lights and reel. These cost approximately (\$200 - \$400).

Dive lights (primary and backup)

Reel

Knife , Shears
